

Instructions for Prostatic Ultrasound with Gold Seeds

- Use Fleet enema 1- 1 1/2 hours before your scheduled appointment
(This may depend on your travel time to our office)
- Take one antibiotic tablet provided one hour before the procedure.
- Aspirin must be discontinued seven days before the testing. If you take any other blood thinning medication (such as Persantine, Motrin, Advil or Coumadin) please call your medical doctor for instructions on discontinuing the medication for the biopsy.

It is the patient responsibility to notify the oncologist as to when their appointment is with our office so that the Gold Seeds are delivered in enough time before the procedure.

- There are no dietary restrictions. You may eat breakfast or lunch before the testing.

On the day of your appointment, please report to The Urology Surgical Practice of Princeton, a JCAHO accredited office based surgical center in Suite P located in the building next door to our main office. Take the sidewalk between our main building and the one next door, follow the sidewalk down between the buildings to the last door on the left, inside the foyer our suite is to the right. You will be required to sign a consent form for your physician to perform this procedure.
